## THE WORK WE DO

Officers assess our clients using the YLS/ CMI tool to determine their risk to reoffend and their treatment needs. Higher risk youth with elevated needs are supervised more intensely by armed Deputy Probation Officers in the community. Officers work collaboratively with families and evidence based treatment providers to ensure treatment goals are met and the youth are successful in meeting their conditions of probation. Additionally, many officers assigned to the community supervision units are integrated into the local school districts and work closely with school officials to promote daily attendance, increase academic performance, and improve student safety.
