


#### **REDY-Go Field Process**

Reentry Team via Transition Liaison and Case Managing PO Warm Handoff

#### R.E.D.Y-Go (Re-Entry Development for Youth)

Re-entry services and planning are utilized to transition youth who have been in out-of-home placements or who have served periods of confinement back to their home communities. The Reentry process promotes public safety and ensures on-going, positive youth development.

The Re-Entry Team includes representatives from Probation Field Services, Behavioral Health Services, Medical, Sacramento County Office of Education, parent/guardian, youth, assigned Probation Officer (s) and any other identified participants (counselor, mentor, etc.) who are involved in the youth's life.

The Re-Entry Team Meetings are held weekly and establish action plans to assist the youth and parent/guardian with school enrollment, counseling services, vocational training, employment assistance, resume building, mentorships, specialized program referrals, and pro-social community activities.

## REDY- Go Placement Process

Placement Probation Officer submits a Re-Entry referral to the Liaison 45-60 days prior to a youth returning home

Re-Entry Liaison attends the scheduled CFT Strengths/ Needs Assessment completed

Re-Entry Liaison begins case planning and transitional services with the youth, their family, and Placement Probation Officer

REDY-Go Team meeting attendees: youth, parent/ guardian, Behavioral Health, School Transition Specialist, POP Coordinator, Placement PO, Juvenile Field PO, Re-Entry Liaison, and Re-Entry Community Officer, and the identified support representative (s)
