**Overview**

The State Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Budget included Public Safety Realignment, which shifted the responsibility of specified offenders from the state to counties. As part of the realignment plan, the Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) Executive Committee was formed to develop and recommend an annual local plan to the Board of Supervisors on how Public Safety Realignment should be implemented within the county. One of the members of the CCP is required to be a chief of police. It is recommended that the Board appoint Sacramento Police Chief Sam D. Somers Jr. to the CCP Executive Committee.

**Recommendation**

Adopt the attached Resolution recommending the designation of Sacramento Police Chief Sam D. Somers Jr. to the Community Corrections Partnership Executive Committee.

**Fiscal Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this recommendation.

**BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

The State Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Budget included Public Safety Realignment, which shifted the responsibility of specified offenders from the state to counties. As part of the realignment plan, the Community Corrections Partnership (CCP) Executive Committee was formed to develop and recommend an annual local plan to the Board of Supervisors on how Public Safety Realignment should be implemented within the county. One of the members of the CCP is required to be a chief of police. County Counsel has opined that the Board of Supervisors has the authority to appoint non-county members to the CCP.

In December 2012, Sacramento Police Chief Rick Braziel resigned thereby creating a vacancy on the Executive Committee of the CCP. The Chair of the CCP was contacted on February 20, 2013, by Citrus Heights Police Chief Christopher Boyd and informed that the local police chiefs had met and discussed the vacancy and recommended that Sacramento Police Chief Sam D.

Somers Jr. be appointed to fill it. At their February 28, 2013, meeting, the CCP unanimously voted to recommend that the Board of Supervisors appoint Chief Somers.

It is recommended that the Board appoint Sacramento Police Chief Sam D. Somers Jr. to the CCP Executive Committee.
