<ul> <li>Opinions from some members regarding lack of stable housing as the main factor of recidivism.</li> <li>Concerns regarding housing budget reduction in JJRBG plan. SB 823 funds in addition to outside funds were used to support unanticipated increased costs in treatment services and impacts to medical personnel workload.</li> <li>Suggestion to prioritize increase in housing budget by reallocating funds from other components of the plan.</li> <li>Probation staff announced grant award from OYCR – \$2 million over 2-year period to help support 10 youth with housing needs.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Two members provided edits to the plan. Members were encouraged to provide updates. Probation has made several updates for consideration.</li> <li>Streamline the process to update the plan and provide regular data reporting, towards end of calendar year for inclusion in annual submission. This is to take effect in the upcoming year.</li> <li>Steps to outline from last month: 1) provide draft of plan for February's meeting with voting taking place in April.</li> <li>Current data components in plan were based on DJJ population demographics, prior to them coming back to Sacramento.</li> <li>Will use a snapshot of data on January 1, 2024 to show what the population looks like and then do a further study on that population snapshot.</li> <li>Suggestion to increase housing budget and to encourage youth coming out of Valley Oak Youth Academy to participate in programs offered.</li> <li>Suggestion to add additional column in plan budget that shows actuals of what was spent in past budget years.</li> </ul>
