SACRAMENTO COUNTY PROBATION DEPARTMENT ARRESTS TWO WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF SACRAMENTO POLICE DEPARTMENT

Sacramento, CA – On February 28, 2018, the Sacramento County Probation Department, with the assistance of the Sacramento Police Department, concluded an investigation resulting in the arrest of two individuals on multiple charges. The operation was the result of several weeks of investigation by probation officers who suspected one of the subjects was in possession of a stolen firearm from Reno, NV. Both subjects were arrested in a house on the 2000 block of 67th Avenue, in Sacramento. Subject Tyrend Goins, 26 years of age, was arrested for transportation of methamphetamine, possession for sale of methamphetamine, possession of a firearm by a convicted felon, possession of ammunition by a convicted felon, unlawful taking of a vehicle, possession of a stolen vehicle, possession of a stolen gun and violating the terms and conditions of Probation. Subject Patricia Espinoza, 37 years of age, was arrested for possession of drug paraphernalia, possession of methamphetamine and violating the terms and conditions of Probation.

The operation resulted in the seizure of:

- Approximately 31.6 grams of methamphetamine
- Loaded 9mm semi-automatic pistol
