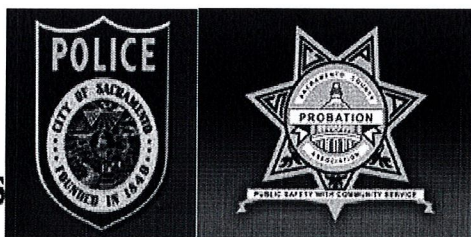
- ❖ A trusting relationship, a caring individual who offers guidance, support and encouragement
