Early Intervention Services

- Multi-Systemic Therapy
- Functional Family Therapy
- Wraparound



Engaging Families: Referral & Assessment

- Engagement begins after Court
 - In custody and community
- Assessment of needs
- Meeting the areas of need for each specific youth and family
- Referral process to Wraparound providers



Early Intervention Unit

- Caseload Responsibilities
 - Reports
 - Child and Family Team Meetings
 - Bi-Weekly Meetings
 - Contact with families and providers



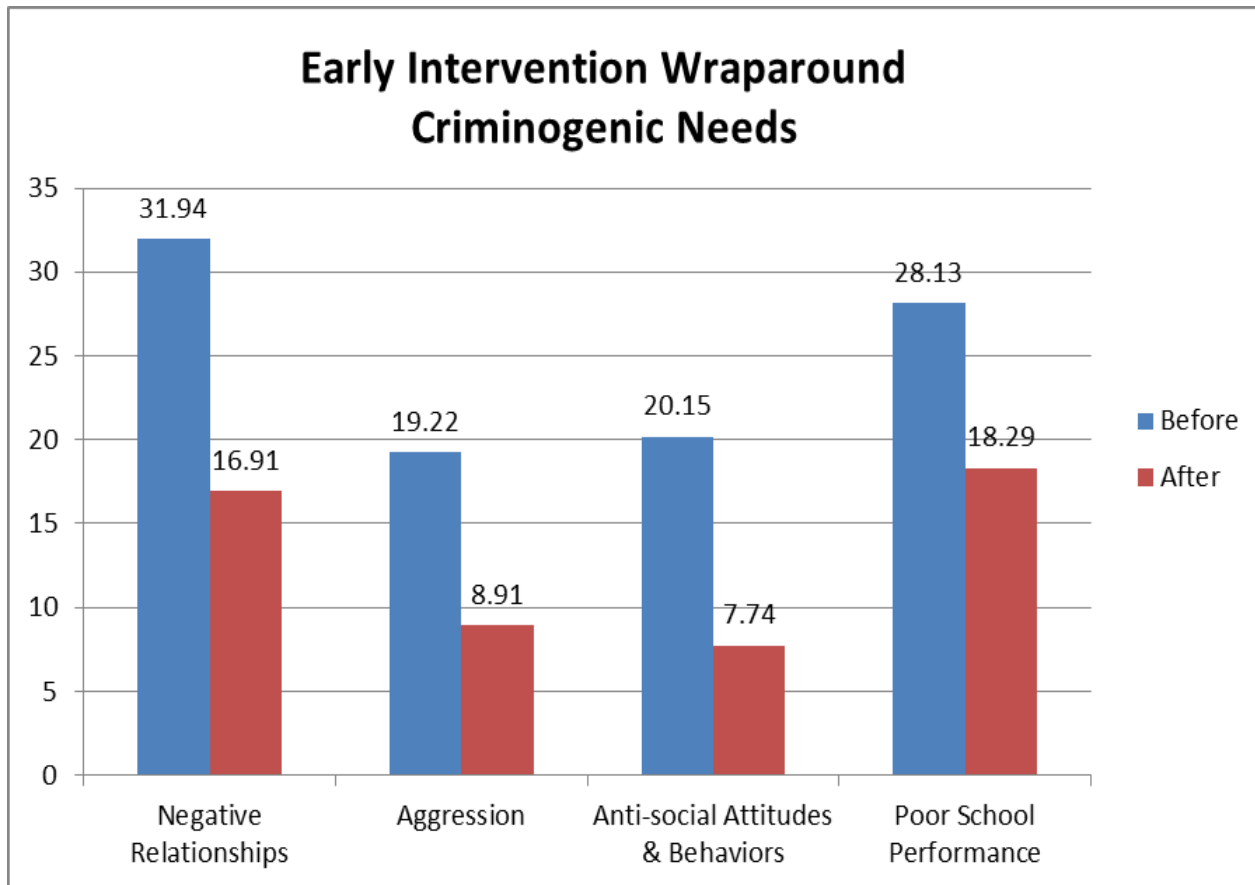
Engaging Families: Role of the Probation Officer

 - Child Family Team Meetings (CFT)



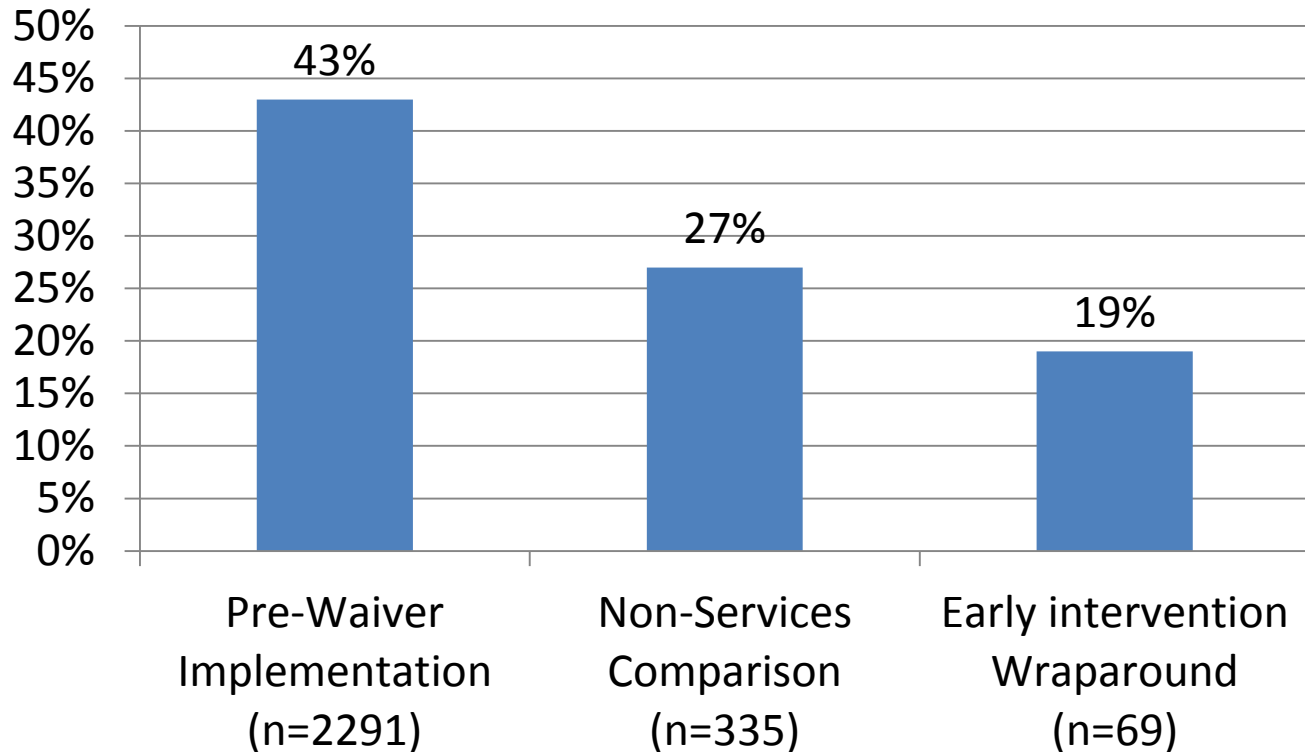
Preliminary Outcomes
