



Weekly Activity Log

The following information listed in the Weekly Activity Log provides a snapshot of significant actions by Probation Officers in the community of Sacramento. The events reported are preliminary actions, taken in the field by Probation Officers, and may or may not be referred for further investigation. Certain details of these incidents have been removed due to potential follow up investigation and/or for privacy rights.

Week of July 13, 2019 to July 19, 2019:

JULY 17, 2019 (FELON IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM) - DISTRICT 2

Officers from the Adult Day Reporting Center Central Unit conducted a home visit of a known subject on Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS). A probation search of the residence produced a loaded .45 caliber semi-automatic handgun, 484 rounds of live ammunition in 13 different calibers, narcotic paraphernalia, methamphetamine, and illegal fireworks. The PRCS subject was arrested for Felon in Possession of a Firearm and Felon in Possession of Ammunition. The subject was booked at the Sacramento Main Jail. A male subject also contacted at the home was cited for Failing to secure a Firearm from a Prohibited Person and Possession of Dangerous Fireworks.



JULY 17, 2019 (FELON IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM) - DISTRICT 3

Officers from the Prop 63 Unit contacted three subjects in a vehicle. The driver was on Informal Searchable Probation, one passenger was on Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS), and the other passenger was on Mandatory Supervision. A records check revealed both the PRCS subject as well as the Mandatory Supervision subject had active felony warrants. A probation search of the vehicle was conducted and officers found a loaded .38 caliber revolver in the center console. All three subjects were arrested and booked at the Sacramento Main Jail for Possession of a Firearm and Felon in Possession of Ammunition.
