Weekly Activity Log

The following information listed in the Weekly Activity Log provides a snapshot of significant actions by Probation Officers in the community of Sacramento. The events reported are preliminary actions, taken in the field by Probation Officers, and may or may not be referred for further investigation. Certain details of these incidents have been removed due to potential follow up investigation and/or for privacy rights.

July 20, 2019 to August 2, 2019

JULY 22, 2019 (MINOR IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM) - DISTRICT 1



Officers from the Prop 63 Unit contacted a subject in a vehicle. The driver was on Juvenile Searchable Probation and currently had an active No Bail Warrant. A probation search of the vehicle produced a loaded .38 cal. Revolver located near the center console of the vehicle. The subject was arrested for Minor in Possession of a Firearm, Minor in Possession of Ammunition, and the warrant. The subject was transported and booked at the Youth Detention Facility.

JULY 30, 2019: (POSSESSION OF HEROIN FOR SALES) - DISTRICT 3

Officers from the Gang Unit contacted a known probationer suspected of selling narcotics in the area. A probation search of his person by officers produced heroin, methamphetamine, and approximately \$624.00 in cash. The subject was arrested for Possession of Methamphetamine for Sales, and Possession of a Controlled Substance for Sales and booked at the Sacramento Main Jail.



JULY 31, 2019: (FELON IN POSSESSION OF A FIREARM) - DISTRICT 1



Officers from the Prop 63 Unit conducted a probation search of a known probationer's residence. During the course of the probation search, officers found a .22 cal. Rifle, multiple rounds of live handgun and rifle ammunition, narcotic paraphernalia, and crystal methamphetamine. The subject was arrested for Felon in Possession of a Firearm, Felon in Possession of Ammunition, Possession of Methamphetamine, and Possession of Narcotic Paraphernalia and booked at the Sacramento Main Jail.
