



Weekly Activity Log

The following information listed in the Weekly Activity Log provides a snapshot of significant actions by Probation Officers in the community of Sacramento. The events reported are preliminary actions, taken in the field by Probation Officers, and may or may not be referred for further investigation. Certain details of these incidents have been removed due to potential follow up investigation and/or for privacy rights.

Week of October 28, 2019 to November 1, 2019

10/29/2019 Probation Compliance Sweep– District 5

Officers from the Adult Community Corrections Divisions, along with officers from the Rancho Cordova Police Department conducted a one day operation at the Mather Community Campus housing program. The purpose of the operation is to contact probationers living at this campus and ensure they are in compliance with their conditions of probation, as well as to assist Volunteers of America in providing a drug-free environment for their various programs on site. Officers conducted multiple probation searches, compliance checks, address verifications, and served warrants resulting in the following stats:

Probationers Contacted: 16

Probation Searches Conducted: 32

Out of Custody VOP's: 3

In-Custody VOP's: 3

Fresh Crimes: 2

Evidence/Property Seized: methamphetamine, narcotic paraphernalia including glass pipes, several explosives to include illegal fireworks, prescription medication, and a shuriken weapon.



10/30/2019 (OPERATION NIGHT WATCH)

The Sacramento S.A.F.E Team comprised of officers from the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department, Sacramento Police Department, State Parole, and Sacramento County Probation Department conducted a one night Halloween operation focusing on contacted Supervised Sex Offenders at their homes who have been ordered by the court not to associate with minors. This Operation was also assisted by numerous Adult Field and Juvenile Field Officers. As a result of this operation, officers conducted numerous home visits, probation searches, and compliance checks yielded the following statistics:

Home Visits and Probation Searches Conducted: 55

Violation of Probation Arrests: 2

Fresh Arrests: 2 (Failing to register as a convicted sex offender),
(Possession of counterfeit money)

Warrant Arrests: 1
