- Direct Experience with Juvenile Justice System
- Experience with Victims and Housing

4. Sac Kids First Presentation	Nia Moore Weathers from Youth Forward

Nia Moore Weathers from Youth Forward provided a general overview of Sac Kids First. They are involved with the youth justice implementation process of SB 823. They advocate for youth voice in leadership and a partnership to increase investments and racial and social equity in cities policies. Nia stated that Prop 64 was one of their primary focuses. Sac Kids First is the region's largest coalition with 36 organizations and 1900 members. Some of the partner organizations are:

- Public Health Advocates
- Alliance for Education Solutions
- Pro Youth and Families
- Anti-Recidivism Coalition
- Self-Awareness and Recovery (SAR)
- Project Optimism

<u>Public Comment:</u> Josef Gray stated that he was thankful of Sac Kids First for their advocacy for the young people. Chairperson Yarber addressed Prop 64 as being for the City funds and not the County, which dictates who is eligible for the funds. There is the possibility of more rounds of funding in the future.

Julie Wherry provided an update on the Juvenile Justice Block Grant Annual Plan. It is posted on the Probation website. There have been some programming changes.
