# 5. **ACTION ITEM:** Considerations of Delegates for Community Members

The Chair asked if this body supports the idea of delegates for community members. Member Matulia stated each member should nominate their own delegates and take account of them. County Counsel Rick Heyer reminded everyone the process to get it approved. The parent body of JJCC subcommittee would need to approve the idea of alternates and want some voice of who those alternates would be. If approved, it wouldn't happen before the next JJCC meeting. Member Ibarra suggested she would delegate someone from her organization with the same level of skills working with the youth and community. Member Gray believes going through the process of selecting delegates is worth it, and the delegate who would take his place would have the same level of work experience, same position, and same perspective. County Counsel Rick Heyer suggested to have bylaws set in place before presenting it to the parent committee. Member Matulia stated he had a lot of board experience and volunteered to draft up the bylaws to be able to present to the parent body. Motion for Delegates of Community members was approved.
