- Many discussions are taken place without resolutions.
- Is the role to give Probation direction or guidance?
- The role of the committee has gone beyond the statute.
- Committee is responsible for creating the report for OYCR and the Board of Supervisors.
- Regroup back to the report
- Possibly create a new group to focus on the other areas discussed within the committee.
  - Tiffany Synnott agrees with Judge Calabretta but would like to know is the report needed once a year, when would the group begin and end?
  - Nancy is concerned with not meeting
  - o Meeting continues to build relationships with each agency
  - Need to regroup to be successful
  - Josef agrees that now we work on next year's report
- 749.22 language on the statute
  - o Chief Yarber and Judge Calabretta believe that language is only for the JJCC and not the subcommittee.
- Dennis Dulay recommends creating a steering committee for how VOYA operates.
- Many great ideas are discussed but need to be prioritized.
- Probation can't lead each idea. If each member can take on an idea to lead, more could be accomplished.
- Chief Deputy Gonzalez was able to recruit an officer to complete a life skills class for the youth.
- Probation is doing their best with the funds that are provided.
- At times there is a disconnect and miscommunication with the group.
- Bulk of block grant goes towards officers/supervision instead of goals that they would like to complete.
- Nancy Smith would be willing to volunteer to take on a project that is identified by the group.
- Judge Calabretta believes someone should go before the Board the Supervisors and report out that the Block Grant is not enough funding. Possibly ask for a growth request.
- Probation will have to provide General Funds to assist operations.
- CD Maria Gonzalez welcomes anyone who would like to see what goes on inside the operations of the Youth Detention Facility.
- Double bunking residents could cause use of force issues.
- There is currently 1 VOYA unit open and 9 other units for a total of 10 active units within YDF.
