

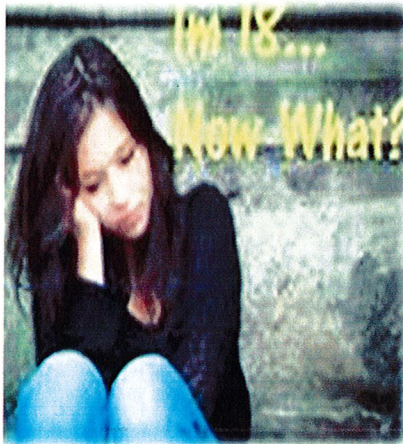


SBYHC Housing

Shores Bridges Youth Housing Collaboration (SBYHC) is an independent living program for survivors of sexual exploitation, aged-out foster youth and youth victims of crime for females 18-24. We will be a place of peace and restoration for residents. Our core values are: **Non-judgement, Empowerment, Transparency, Honor and Respect.**



Our Program:

Bridge Network in collaboration with Shores of Hope SBYHC is a residential “dormitory” style program. Our program offers the opportunity for transition aged youth to have their lives transformed and restored. Our program assists with the development of successful independent living and self-sustainability. Length of stay is based on individual life goals of each resident.

SBYHC Housing provides our clients counseling, teaching and community involvement to help our residents explore principles for life-long success that lead to economic independence.
