3. Housing Resources For The Re-entry Population	Susan Lal, Program Manager and Alondra Neira, Planner of Homeless Services and Housing
<p>Susan Lal and Alondra Neira from Homeless Services and Housing services provided a general overview of Programs and Services available. Susan and Alondra discussed several programs including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Prevention and Intervention for Transitional Age Youth (TAY) for ages 18-24• Francis House Diversion Program• Emergency Sheltering for Families with Minor Children• Transitional Housing at Mather for Families with Minor Children (Mather has a current capacity of 46-48 households)• Transitional Housing for Former Foster Youth <p>There are 30 scattered sites. Average length of program stay 18 months to 3 years. These programs do allow pets.</p> <p><u>Public Comment:</u> None</p>
